Symposium is a cyclic event which was started in the 70's by the Department of Swimming at the University of Physical Education - Wrocław, Poland. The event promotes original scientific theories regarding physical activity in an aquatic environment.

Especially, we would like to invite scientists (researchers) and practitioners (teachers, coaches, athletes), undergraduate, graduate, Ph.D. students who are working in various fields of physical culture related to physical activity in the aquatic environment.

An important aspect of the Symposium theme is to deepen public awareness in the area of health-related function of motor activity related to the aquatic environment.

The Symposium theme covers the biological and humanistic aspects of physical education and sport, tourism, recreation and rehabilitation in the aquatic environment. Such broad subject matter is mainly taken in the axiological and pedagogical, physiological and biomechanical context.

Aim

The aim of the Symposium is creation of interdisciplinary background of cooperation and exchange experiences between practices controlling physical activity and representatives of science who represent different scientific disciplines they operate in the area of the aquatics.

Thematic scope

- Biological and humanistic aspects of physical education, rehabilitation, sport, recreation in the water environment.
- Theories and implementations in motor learning at water environment.
- Contemporary trends in theory and practice of swimming training and other swimming sports (water polo, synchronous swimming, fins swimming, water rescue, under water hockey etc.).
- Modern problems of aquatic activity forms.
- Water sports (sailing, windsurfing, kayak polo, water ski, wakeboard, etc.).
