GENERAL INFORMATION

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Step 1:** Nomination by home university (via email).
Step 2: Complete the International Exchange Application form and Confirmation of English Language Skills form.
Step 3: Obtain original or certified copies of university transcripts.
Step 4: Submit forms and transcripts via email to asheppar@stfx.ca.
Step 5: Receive letter of acceptance and student information.
Step 6: Submit course selections and apply for residence.

(Fall Semester)**

**January – April
(Winter Semester)**

A minimum of 2 months is expected for students to receive approval from StFX and make travel arrangements.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

Exchange students applying to StFX are required to provide evidence of their English language competency. This can be done by having the home coordinator sign the Confirmation of English Competency Form, or by providing evidence of one of the following English language certifications (with a minimum score of): TOEFL IBT (80), TOEFL Paper (550), IELTS (6.5, with 6.0 in each band), CAEL (60), or CAE - C1 (180, with 170 in each band).

COURSE REQUIREMENTS/RESTRICTIONS

Exchange students are required to take a minimum of 9 credits (3 courses) per semester, however a full course load per semester is 15 credits (5 courses). Some courses require prerequisites. This information is indicated in the course descriptions that can be found in the Academic Calendar. Some exceptions are made for exchange students, however this is at the discretion of the professor.

AUXILIARY FEES

Exchange students are **not** required to pay StFX tuition fees, however they are required to pay several service/auxiliary fees. For the 2019-2020 year the fees are: Full Year (Two Semesters) - \$932.70 One Semester - \$466.35

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING

MEALS

Students who decide to live on-campus must purchase either a meal plan or declining balance plan (DCB). The DCB functions like a debit card when the student purchases food items on campus. For meal plan rates please visit: www2.mystfx.ca/university-housing/rates-fees

Off-campus students should budget \$80 – \$120 per week.

OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING

Off-campus housing prices in Antigonish range from \$500-600 a month for shared apartments or houses, to \$600+ per month for a one-bedroom apartment. Incoming students are responsible for making their own arrangements to live off campus.

ARRIVAL SERVICES

Upon arrival in Canada, transportation from Halifax Airport to StFX campus will be provided.

TRANSPORTATION

Most places are within walking distance of campus. Community bus service runs from Monday to Friday between 9:00am – 5:00pm and costs \$2. Local taxi service is between \$5 and \$7 per ride. Bus to Halifax International Airport is \$50 one way.

HEALTH INSURANCE

All exchange students are required to purchase medical insurance from the StFX Students' Union Health Plan. This coverage is \$480 (CDN) per semester. For information about the health and dental coverage under this plan, please visit: theu.ca/health-dental
