Re: Call for nominations for 2020

Dear Colleagues,

I am writing to you to invite nominations of master graduates to the Arenberg-Coimbra Group Prize for Erasmus Students in 2020. You may well know the regulations from earlier nomination rounds, but if in doubt, you can always find them on our web site.

We are now opening the 2020 Arenberg-Coimbra Group Prize for nominations. The deadline for candidates to come forward at individual Coimbra Group Universities is 30 November, i.e. in just over a month's time. In view of the fairly late date of launching the call, we shall accept that individual universities use flexibility. The important part is that the nominations of individual CG Universities will reach the Executive Board by 31 January 2020, in accordance with the Regulations.

The Executive Board will establish a selection committee to find the best candidate to be announced at the end of March 2020 and at the General Assembly in Montpellier on 12 June 2020.
