The main campus of the faculty consists of many interconnected buildings and sports facilities. It can be difficult to find your way around the campus at first, so here is a brief overview of the most important places. The main entrance takes you to the largest building on campus – Block H. This is where most of the classrooms and offices are located, as well as all the important departments of the faculty, such as the Dean's Office and the Study Department. Classrooms are marked as U with an assigned number and lecture halls as P with an assigned number.

Most of the sports facilities are located on the west side of the campus. In block F you will find a newly built multipurpose gym and an elliptical gym. On the large outdoor area there are outdoor sports facilities such as an athletic oval, a football field, beach volleyball courts or also an overflow hall for ball sports.

You can find refreshments on the east side of the campus, specifically in Building E. There is a newly renovated canteen with a wide range of food and beverages, complemented by a café and a pastry shop. The latter also offers a gluten-free range.

The last important part of the faculty is the inner courtyard. This connects all parts and buildings of the campus, including its sports fields, classrooms or student dormitories. It is also an ideal place for leisure activities. Students use this place a lot for studying, relaxing or for playing netball, which can be played on the field in the middle of the courtyard.

The faculty also has other teaching spaces available, which you will gradually become familiar with. They are either in Praque, e.g. Tyršův dům, or outside of Prague, where we go for courses.

What do you need to enroll?

- ✓ valid passport or other ID
- ✓ verified copy of your previous qualification (i.e. High School graduating certificate / Diploma)
- ✓ original of the sport doctor's physical examination report (in English or Czech language only)
- ✓ proof of payment of tuition fees (i.e. receipt)
- \checkmark writing materials

ISIC card

What does an ISIC card bring you?

- ✓ officially confirmed internationally recognised student status
- ✓ transport discounts
- discounts on meals at Charles University canteens and other providers
- borrowing at Charles University libraries
- free access to the facilities of Charles University (e.g.: dormitories, study rooms...)
- copying services provided at some faculties
- discounts in some shops and admission to some cultural events, galleries, museums, sports venues

Your ISIC card is valid for one year and you can use it until 31st December of the following year. After that you have to renew its validity, and you do this every year (in the form of a holographic sticker on the back of the card).

As our student, you are only entitled to one student card (even if you are enrolled in more than one study programme at the university). If you want to know more, check out www.isic.cz.

Electronic platforms used at our university

First, you enter one system, then you can get into the others. The systems may not be design-friendly, but they are understandable. You can't go wrong by trial and error and you will gradually find your way around.

System No. 1 CAS CU

The purpose of CAS (Central Authentication Service) is to simplify the way users log in to applications so that they can use the same username and password everywhere.

Login name

You can use your faculty login name as your login name. or your personal number, which is printed on your CU ID card below your photo.

Forgotten password

If you forget your password, you can change it by entering some personal details using this **link**. But beware, a password set in this way is not considered trustworthy and you will lose access to some applications. To fully regain access to all apps, you will need to collect a new initial password in person from the dispensing centre.

Nou can also use CAS to log in to the Eduroam Internet network (see the Internet chapter).

2 System No. 2 SIS CU

The Student Information System (SIS) is used at Charles University for enrolling in courses, logging into the study schedule, registering for exams, assigning bachelor's theses, etc.

What can you choose as an elective?

You can choose between:

- \checkmark recommended electives (see Karolínka)
- compulsory courses from other disciplines (Check in SIS $\overline{\mathbf{v}}$ that the course can be taken outside the curriculum.)
- lifelong learning courses that you can have accepted \checkmark as electives
- courses from other faculties \checkmark
- All the courses you log in and enroll into in SIS are binding.
- Check your course enrollment before the end of the enrollment period.

How do I get a study certificate?

Curriculum

- Section of study = study year
- The study plan for a given section of study consists of compulsory (P), compulsory elective (PV) and elective courses (V).
- You will enroll in the courses via the Study Information System (SIS).
- The minimum number of credits to complete the Bachelor's degree programme is 180.
- The minimum number of credits to complete the follow-up Master's programme is 120.
- The curriculum for the first year is fixed and you can get information about it at Orientation days or at Student Point from the Student team or the International Student Office.
- From the second year onwards you will choose your study plan.
- Each course is weighted by a certain number of credits; usually from 1 to 6 credits per course.
- The minimum number of credits you must earn to advance to the next year (next section of study):
 - 6 study 50 credits for enrollment in the second stage of study
 - 100 credits for enrollment in the third stage of study
 - 150 credits for enrollment in the fourth stage of study

Sport Doctor's Physical Examination

It is mandatory for all sports degree programs for the entire period of study. The certificate must be turned in to the International Student Office prior to

A sport doctor's physical examination is valid for one year from the date of issue.

schedule registration.

In the event that an appointment with a sports physician is not available until after the registering of study schedule, the International Student Office must be notified (this is an exception with only a number of days to spare, as the examination is required to begin studies).

DORMITORIES

... aka different aspects of student life

Charles University offers various accommodation services that you may or may not use. There are advantages and disadvantages to living together as a student, so consider what suits you best. Most students opt for shared living in rentals, which works out similarly financially to dormitories.

What's all there?

- ✓ Number of beds per room: 2-3
- ✓ Shared facilities: kitchenette, automatic washing machine, toilets, showers
- ✔ Room: fridge, bed, table, chairs, wardrobe, internet Eduroam

How do I apply for a dorm accommodation?

- Only the faculty coordinator can apply for the Charles University dormitory for international students. First year students have thus their accommodation automatically reserved by the faculty.
- Freshmen students might also welcome the housing assistant services available at selected dormitories, which will help you with orientation around your dormitory or other questions/issues.
